

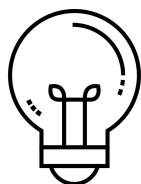
Mobile health technologies, social justice and population-related vulnerabilities

How did we proceed:



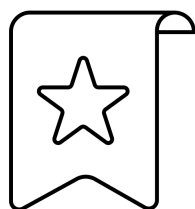
